

Troop 112 – Outdoor Credit (ODC) Troop Practices

August 2013

Any funds in ODC accounts by scouts who are no longer registered with the troop as of January 1, 2013 shall be deposited into the troop's Scholarship Fund and/or troop equipment and supplies.

1. All funds in the accounts are "credits" – and have no monetary value.
2. All credits belong to the troop and may be earned and used by individual scouts/scouters.
3. Use of any credits is at the sole discretion of the troop committee.
4. Credits cannot be withdrawn by an individual scout/scouter in the form of cash or check (money).
5. Credits shall not be used to reimburse a scout/scouter for personal purchases (e.g. camping gear, Troop T-shirt, merit badge kits, etc.).
6. Credits shall only be used to offset the cost of Troop 112 activities and membership dues.
7. Some activities may not accept outdoor credits.
8. Scouts/scouters can earn credits by selling at troop approved fundraisers (e.g. Popcorn, mulch).
9. If a scout/scouter does not re-charter with the unit, the credits will be transferred to the Scholarship Account and/or troop equipment/supplies and the ODC account will be closed on March 1 of each year. This is to provide a 10 week opportunity for the scout/scouter who fails to re-charter the opportunity to do so before the ODC account is closed.
10. Committee Chairman shall have the discretion in the enforcement of the spirit of these practices.
